

TUE processes for AA

Incomplete TUEs will not be considered by the Australian Sports drug Medical Advisory Committee (ASDMAC). On the receipt of a TUE application form, please ensure to check the following;

Application Checklist	
1. Athlete details complete	<input type="checkbox"/>
2. Athlete declaration signed	<input type="checkbox"/>
3. TUE application details complete	<input type="checkbox"/>
4. Medical practitioner details complete	<input type="checkbox"/>
5. Medication details including all medications and treatments tried (generic names and doses)	<input type="checkbox"/>
6. Separate diagnosis and medical evidence attached: (a) Comprehensive medical history; (b) Results of examinations, laboratory investigations, imaging studies and/or specialist medical reports; (c) Copies of original reports or letters (where appropriate).	<input type="checkbox"/> <input type="checkbox"/> <input type="checkbox"/>
7. Medical practitioner declaration signed	<input type="checkbox"/>

Once satisfied that the application is complete, submit the TUE and supporting evidence to;

Advice is usually received within one week of the application being submitted. If the approval is required quicker (due to a major event), phone ASDMAC and explain the circumstances.

AA and the athlete will receive advice about the outcome of the application. TUEs should be kept on record as they are required to be submitted to the IPC prior to a major event.
